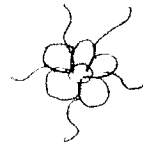
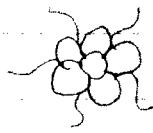

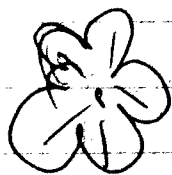
in my heart strongly that sooner or later my dad will come home. It would be even more than appreciating if you let him come home, only

if you judge it and unless you allow it, then my dad comes home. So please let him come back to us, and enjoy life like every American does!

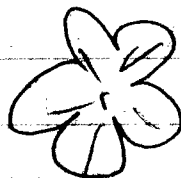
